Great news – after over 3 months of lockdown the Government has finally announced that self catering establishments can reopen from Saturday 4th July 2020.

This means that we will indeed be operational again from Week 27. For the past couple of weeks, having been taken off furlough, the team here have been working hard to bring the resort out of slumber. More importantly we have also been following all the available industry advice and Government guidelines in order to make the resort as “COVID-19 Secure “ as possible.

Our priority now is to send out the first few weeks of pre arrival information as we have less than the usual 5 to 6 weeks window to do this. All owners due to occupy from the 4th July will be contacted in chronological week order.

May we now request that all those owners previously invoiced for weeks 27 to 39, and who may have been “hanging on” to pay them, settle their management fees as soon as possible.

Due to the COVID-19 Secure Guidelines we are required to follow we have had to make some major changes to the way we operate. In particular arrival day will not be the same as before as we have had to revise the whole check in/key collection procedure. Our intention is to provide you with this information well in advance of arrival. This and specific key information regarding the other changes we have had to make will be circulated in the form our reopening FAQ document.

We are of course very pleased that we are now able to welcome you all back to the Lakeland Village. The last few months have been an extremely testing time for all of us, so we are very relieved to be in this position and we wish to thank all those owners who have stuck by us during these unprecedented times.
